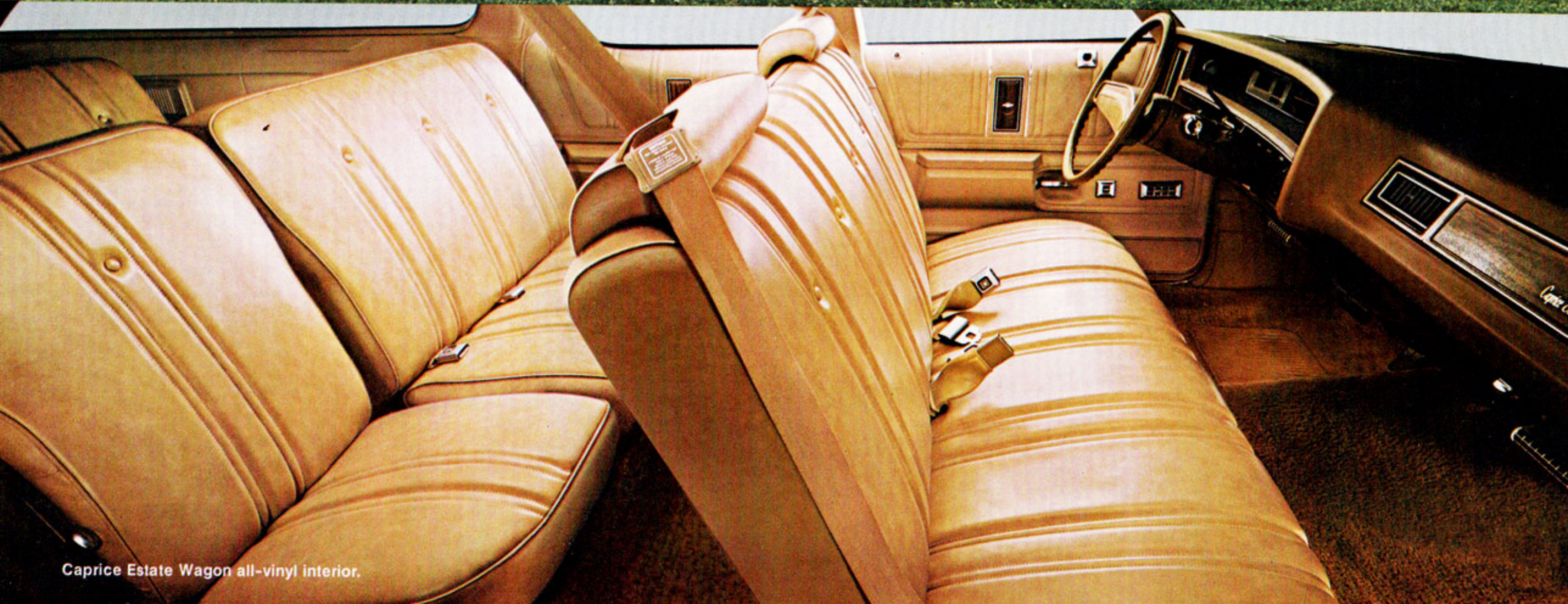

Chevrolet regular-size wagons. For families who want their wagon to be roomy, comfortable and practical.

Station wagon, to many American families, still means four doors, lots of seats, room for inordinate amounts of groceries, luggage or building materials and the ability to pull big travel trailers. That pretty well describes the 1976 regular-size Chevrolet wagons.

Caprice Estate and Impala are the offerings, both available as either 2- or 3-seaters.

Those who appreciate fine styling will note the new grille-

work on Caprice Estate, particularly the dual rectangular headlights. And that distinctive wood-grain vinyl trim that dresses the sides and tailgate is called Mozambique.

Impala has new front styling and offers an impressive array of standard features. Both models provide standard Turbo Hydramatic transmission, power steering, power brakes, a 4-barrel 400-cu.-in. V8 and Chevrolet's Effi-

ciency System, to mention a few.

Interiors are pleasant, comfortable and downright elegant. Easy-to-care-for all-vinyl seat trim is available as well as sport cloth trim. You may also want the available 50/50 front seat with passenger seat back that reclines for outstanding comfort.

What we've mentioned above are the things that make Caprice Estate and Impala fine cars. Now let's see what makes them excep-

tionally practical wagons.

The storage area is well designed. On 3-seaters the third seat faces forward, leaving generous room behind for luggage or whatever. The rear seats convert to cargo floor quickly, and the area is easily loaded through the Glide-Away tailgate.

Rear doors are larger than those on Chevrolet sedans. Wagon-engineered leaf-spring suspension in the rear is well suited for loads.

The Glide-Away tailgate.

This is the tailgate that disappears completely to help make loading easier. Turn the key to the right and the power window glides up into the roof (window may also be operated from the instrument panel). Give the key a further turn and the tailgate drops down to be gently pushed beneath the floor. Reverse the process to close the tailgate. If you order the power tailgate (shown at right), the whole operation is automatic, from the instrument panel or at the tailgate.

Flip-down seats.

Rear seats can be converted to cargo floor from one place . . . the right rear passenger door. Release the catches on the divided second seat and fold the seat backs down. Now pull the remote lever on the wheelhousing and the third seat flips down. A gentle push locks the floor plates in place and you're done, without climbing inside, and without going from door to door.

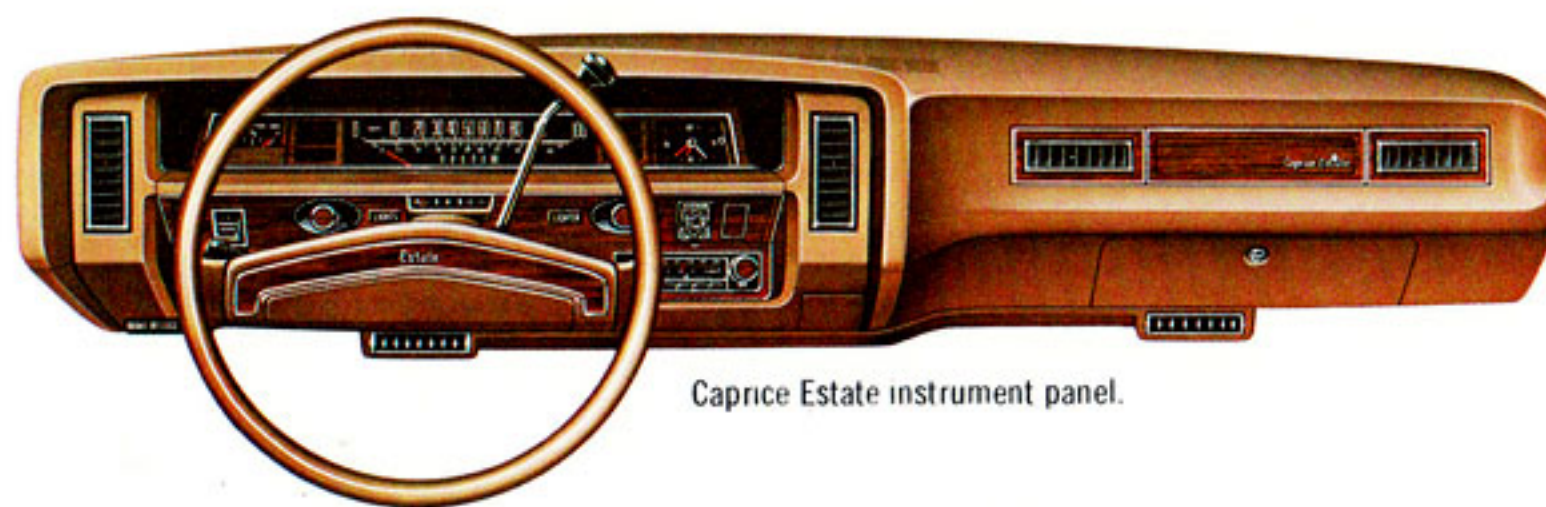

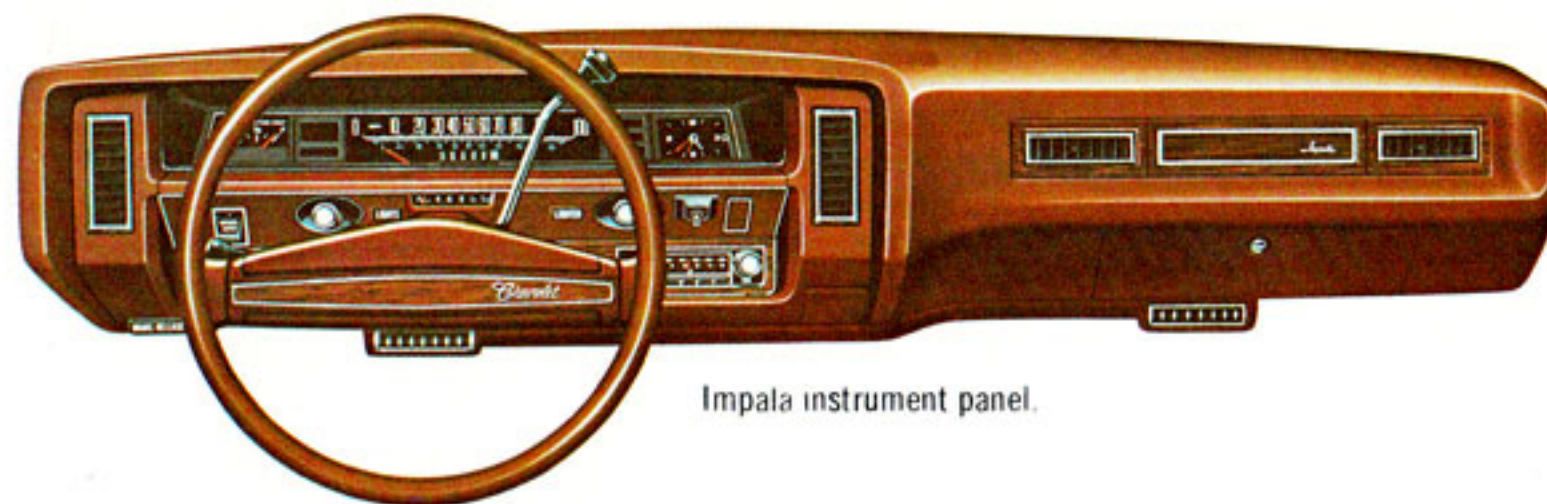

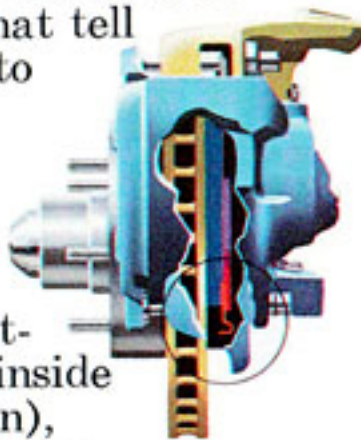

Plenty of comfort and convenience.

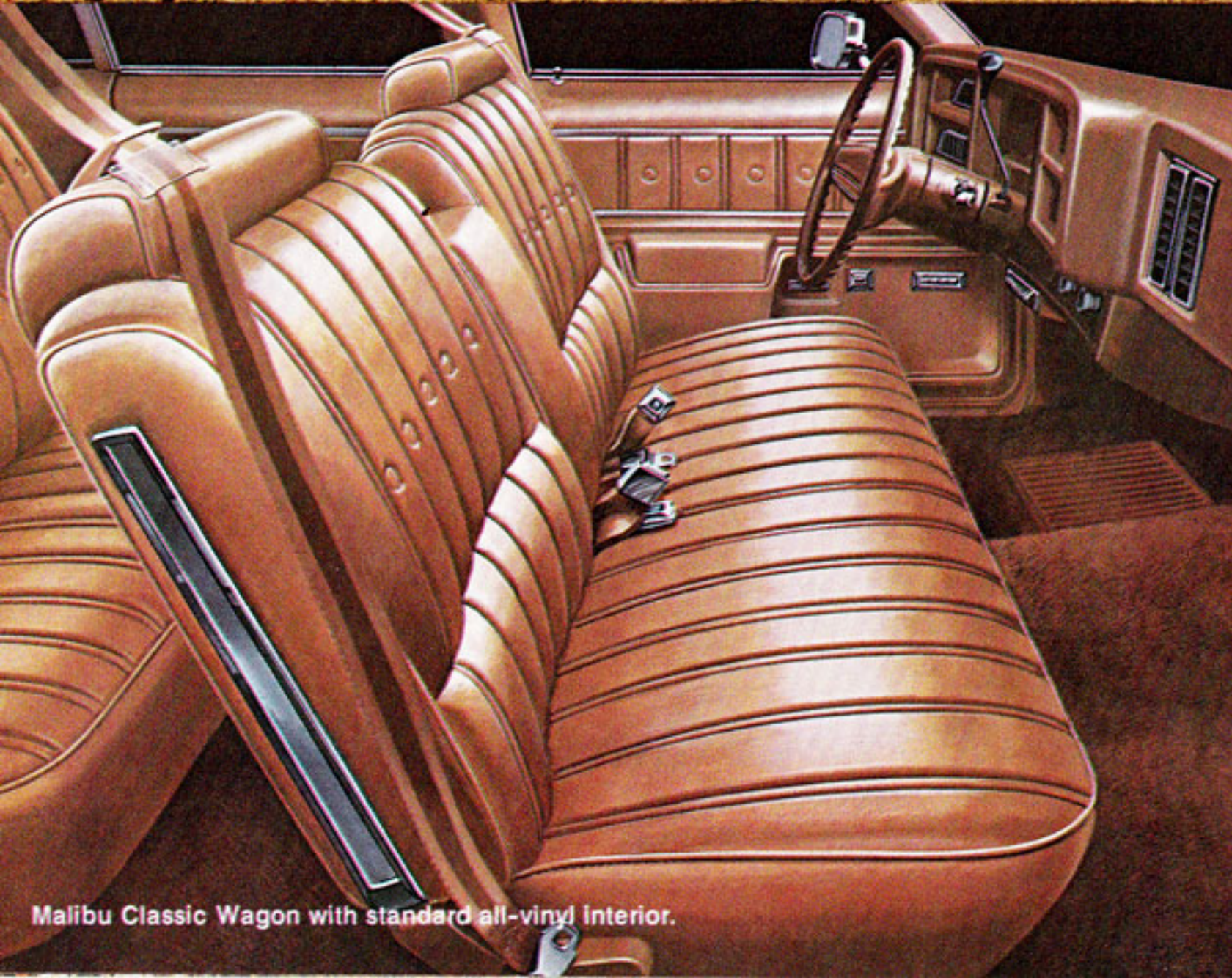

Chevelle mid-size wagons. Just right for more and more of today's families.

"Mid-size" in relation to Chevelle wagons may need a word of explanation. They *will* carry up to eight people in 3-seat versions. They *will* handle up to 85 cubic feet of cargo. The ride *is* smooth and comfortable. Yet many families will find the size and price of Chevelle to be just right for their family and their budget.

Chevelle wagon choices are Malibu, Malibu Classic and Malibu Classic Estate. All are available

with either two or three seats.

It would be difficult to improve on the striking beauty of the Malibu Classic and Classic Estate models. But for '76, it's been done with a bold new front-end treatment set off by a new diamond pattern in the radiator grille and distinctive stacked dual rectangular headlights.

There is nothing modest about the list of Chevelle wagon standards. Power steering, power

brakes, Turbo Hydra-matic transmission and a 350 V8 are included. And, of course, the Chevrolet Efficiency System is standard to help promote smooth, responsive performance.

Sitting in the front seat of the Classic and Classic Estate models, it would be difficult to tell that you're in a wagon. The full foam bench seat in sport cloth-and-vinyl or all-vinyl upholstery has a well-padded fold-down

center armrest. The seat, the instrument panel, the deep carpeting, soft headliner and padded vinyl door panels are all carefully color-keyed.

The basic Malibu interior is highlighted with seats that are full foam construction with washable all-vinyl upholstery. The headliner, molded door trim and rear quarter trim panels, and soft carpeting in the passenger areas are color-keyed.

The liftgate tailgate.

The Chevelle liftgate gets up and out of the way quickly and easily because it is counterbalanced. That's an advantage for the passengers who face rearward on 3-seaters. There are also swing-out rear quarter windows back there for added ventilation. (They're standard on 3-seaters, and you can order them on 2-seaters.) The liftgate can only be opened from the instrument panel or from the outside on 3-seat Chevelle wagons. Both 2- and 3-seat models include a tailgate-ajar warning light. These extra precautions will make you feel more at ease when carrying kids or cargo.

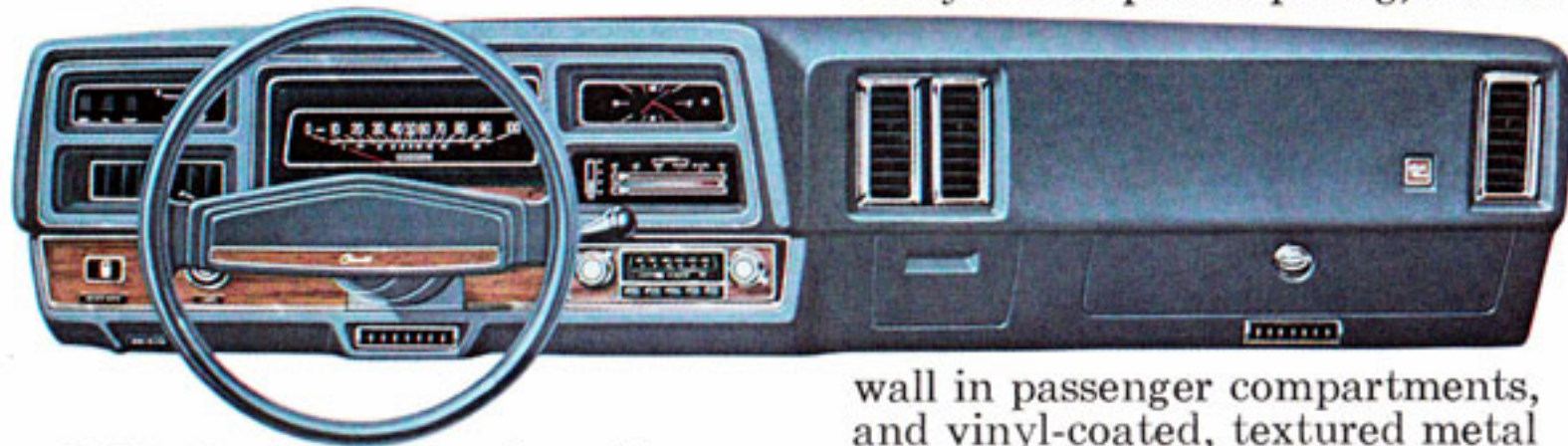

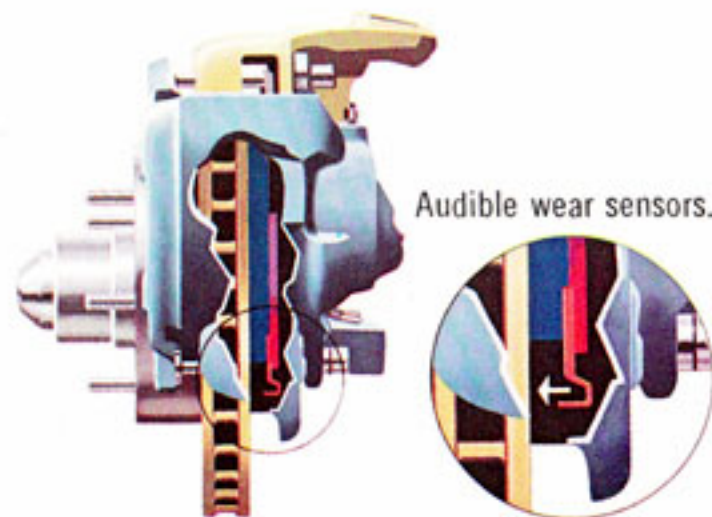

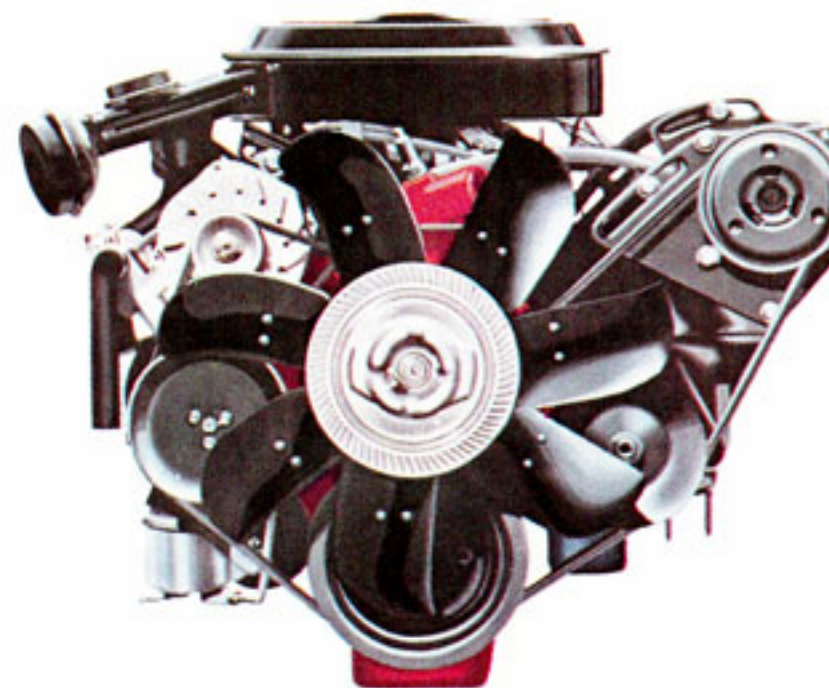

Vega economy-size wagons. Built to take it.

We won't beat around the bush... the 1976 Vega wagon is built to take it.

It has a 60,000-mile or 5-year engine guarantee. (See below.)

Not only is it a tough engine, it's a quiet, low maintenance engine. One reason is its change from mechanical to hydraulic valve lifters.

This year's Vega body is built to fight corrosion. There are

zinc-clad metals, galvanized metals, plastic inner fenders. There are protective coatings of plastisol, mastic, and aluminized wax—at the front end, door and windshield areas, rear quarter panel and rear window. All of these materials help the '76 Vegas resist corrosion.

A sturdy new 5-Speed manual transmission is available this year.

And for quick starts on cold, raw days and up to 22,500 miles

on a set of spark plugs, there's a High Energy Ignition system.

Ruggedness is standard on both Vega wagon models: The regular Vega, or the Estate which has wood-grain vinyl paneling on the sides and tailgate.

There's also a GT package available on either model. It includes, among other things, the GT engine with its staged two-barrel carburetor, a sport sus-

pension system, special 13" x 6" GT wheels, wide A70-13B bias-belted-ply white lettered tires, dual sport mirrors.

Inside, all Vega wagons have comfortable high back front bucket seats. There's a wide choice of colors standard in cloth-and-vinyl or all-vinyl upholstery.

One final point. For all its ruggedness, the price of a Vega is easy to take.

Your storage space.

Vega liftgate swings up and out of the way. With second seat down, you have 46.6 cubic feet of storage space. Compartment under the cargo floor for valuables.

Your engine guarantee.

This 5-year/60,000-mile engine guarantee is an added value feature.

Limited warranty—Chevrolet guarantees to the owners of 1976 Vegas equipped with a 140-cubic-inch, 4-cylinder engine that any authorized Chevrolet dealer will make repairs, without charge to the owner, during the term of the guarantee, to the cylinder block, cylinder head, all internal engine parts, the intake and exhaust manifolds and water pump, made necessary because of defects in material or workmanship.

This guarantee is in addition to the New Vehicle Warranty, but does not apply to repairs required because of misuse, negligence, alteration, accident or lack of reasonable or proper maintenance.

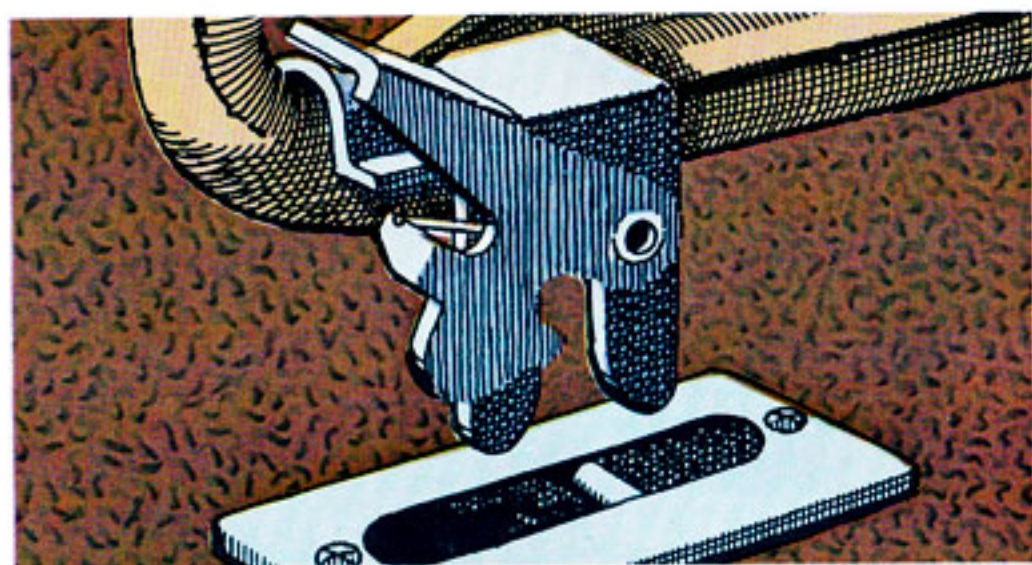


Sportvan is a space vehicle for families.

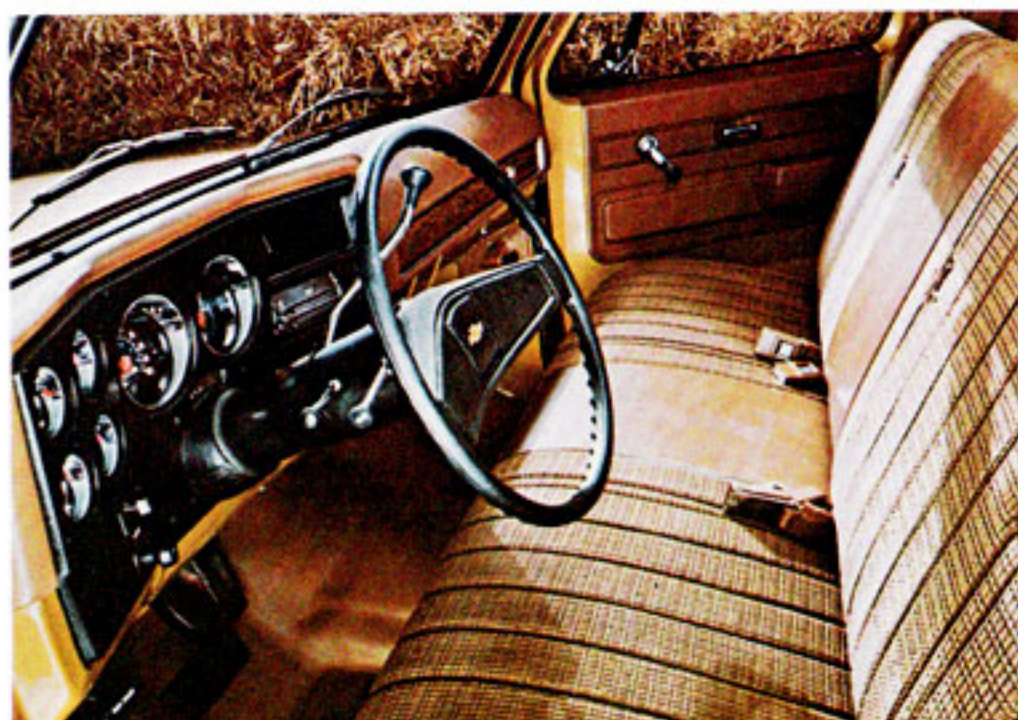
It's available in three series, on either a 125" or 110" wheelbase, and with 6-cylinder or V8 engine. Seating for five is standard. Series 20 Sportvans can carry eight and Series 30 long-wheelbase models up to 12 with available seats.

The Beauville model features a new luxury interior (shown above) available with high-back front bucket seats, choice of woven cloth upholstery with vinyl trim or durable all-vinyl, and door and sidewall trim panels with simulated teakwood inserts.

Side entry is through a sliding door that needs only 4½" clearance. And double rear panel doors open up on 260 cubic feet of cargo room when the standard or available passenger seats are removed by use of new quick release latches (shown below).



Suburban



Some call Suburban the superwagon.

It can take up to nine with available seats, or carry up to 144 cubic feet of cargo—that's about half again as much as many wagons. And you can carry that cargo almost anywhere with Suburban's available full-time or conventional 4-wheel drive.

It comes in two series, and it's available in trim levels that include the Scottsdale (shown above) and the Silverado, with foam-cushioned front seat upholstered in either luxurious ribbed-pattern velour cloth or supple buffalo-hide grained vinyl, with cut-pile polyester carpeting, door trim panels with simulated tigerwood inserts, map pockets on front door trim panels and full-gauge instrumentation.



Suburban is also a remarkable tow vehicle. A Series 20 model can be equipped to pull up to 14,500 pounds, including the weight of the trailer, equipment, passengers and Suburban. Also, you have a choice of rear doors—wagon-type tailgate or large double doors that swing fully open.

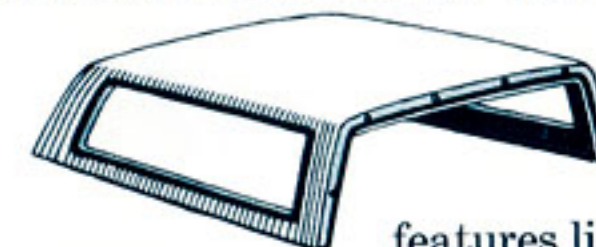
Blazer



Blazer is the go-almost-anywhere sport vehicle.

Blazer was named "4-Wheeler of the Year" by *4-Wheeler Magazine* in 1975. One reason was the available special suspension that provides a very comfortable ride with 4-wheel drive. For 1976, this suspension is standard equipment.

Blazer's hood and front fenders are fabricated from two single sheets of steel. Double-wall construction is also used in doors, windshield pillars, roof, front cowl and rear side panels. Inside, you can specify seating for up to five. Interior choices include the available Cheyenne interior and the standard Custom Deluxe interior (shown above).



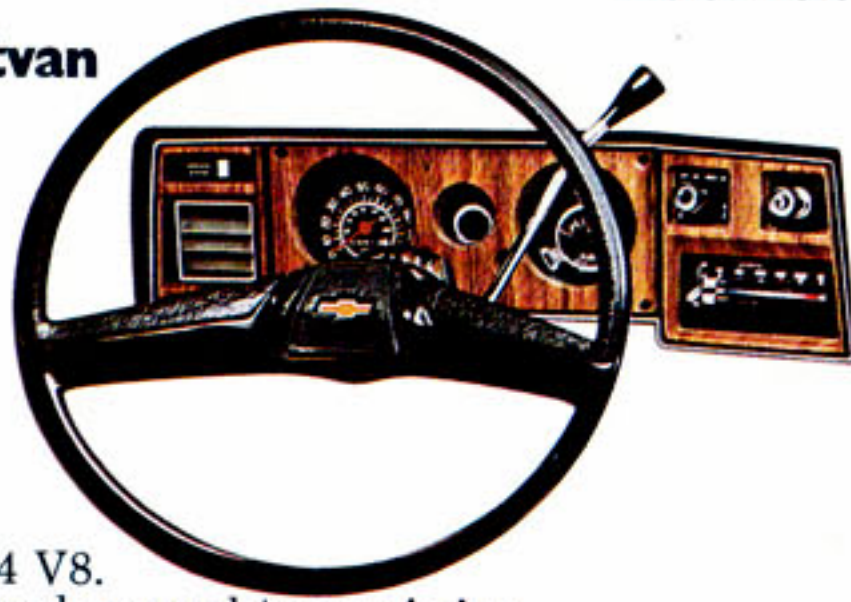
