It's the time you want a full measure of driving comfort. It's the time when you want to make traveling to work, to the store, or on that long-awaited vacation easier, more relaxing and, ves,

more enjoyable.

Driving requires a little less effort with equipment like automatic transmission, power steering, power brakes, steel-belted radial ply tires. As you probably expected. all are standard on Caprice. But there's more standard that you may not have expected: a radial tuned suspension system with front and rear stabilizer bars, modified shock absorbers and other com-

ponents to go along with the tires. We think all this works together to make you more comfortable at the wheel.

After a day's work it's a pleasure to climb into a car like Caprice Classic, Little touches inside help make the traffic outside less

noticeable—like the fold-down center armrest in four-door models. the remote-control left mirror with the knob right at fingertip level in the Landau Coupe.

In any Caprice, a selection of seats is offered: the standard full foam cushioned bench, or the available 50/50 split front seat that adjusts to accommodate the individual seating preferences of both passenger and driver (it even reclines for the passenger side!). Upholstery materials are either a smooth knit cloth-and-vinvl combination or a soft expanded all-vinyl.

In a Caprice Classic you can find the quiet moment you need at the beginning and end of the day. A special sound insulation package is built into every model. That means added insulation around you, in front of you, to the side of you,

and over your head. Plus added padding under the hood and on top of the trunk floor.

The looks of Caprice Classic fit its name, Classic. Check the 1976 styling features like rectangular headlights to see if you don't agree.

However, looks aren't all you expect from your car. Durability is especially important these days when you may be thinking of keeping your car a little longer. That's why the words "Body by Fisher" and the strength, quality and craftsmanship they stand for mean so much. And that's why we've included specific coverage of value items on pages 10 and 11.

Chances are this could be your second or third Impala. But whether you're a newcomer or a third time winner, it's nice to know that Impala is traditionally a full-size car so many people buy and come back to.

Okay, why?

First, there's people room.
Either 2- or 4-door models hold six easily. Nobody's cramped. There's leg room, head room and general stretching room that families need. And backing it all up, there's plenty of trunk room, too.

Then the driver gets treated right with standard equipment like automatic transmission, steel-belted radial ply tires, power steering and power front disc brakes. The driver also gets an engine selection from different V8s.

Impala's designed to get you on

the road and keep you there. A High Energy Ignition helps give better starts in bad weather, compared to a conventional ignition. It's part of the Chevrolet Efficiency System described more fully on page 10. This system helps keep your car running smoothly and, maybe best of all, contributes to fewer recommended tune-ups and oil changes than you're probably used to.

Inside, the '76 Impala has one of the most modern wood looks: rosewood. There's simulated rosewood on the instrument panel and other trim areas. Carpeting's nylon, and you can choose either standard sport cloth or pattern cloth-and-vinyl upholstery with all-vinyl available. Seats are standard bench type or available 50/50 split front seat.

Outside, Impala has clean crisp lines. Its styling stands out most dramatically in the Landau Custom Coupe. Landau is highlighted by a distinctive padded vinyl cover on back roof area only. Also, it includes dual body-color sport mirrors, special wheel covers, deluxe bumpers and fender-to-door accent striping.

However, you may have

decided you need the room of a fullsize car, but want to cut costs wherever you can. Chevrolet's ready for you with the new-for-'76 Impala S. It's a roomy, easy-to-getin-and-out-of 4-door sedan. It's also basic room without some extra trim and steel-belted radial ply tires, which makes it Chevrolet's lowest priced full-size car. Nice bargain for budget-minded families.
