First, take a look at the Malibu Classic Sedan. Its clean, uncluttered and distinctive lines are just a little breathtaking. Go ahead. Get in, sit back and relax in spacious comfort.

If you like a large slice of apple pie, the Malibu Classic Wagon should whet your appetite. Ask your Chevrolet dealer for a Chevy Station Wagon catalog.

Sedans and Wagons feature fixed rear door picture windows with swing-out vents behind them to provide rear seat passengers with draft-free ventilation.

But then, perhaps you're the sporty type. What'll make your heart jump is the Malibu Classic Sport Coupe (shown on cover). Don't let its crisp, sporty appearance fool you, though. Inside, it's as roomy and pleasurable as it is delightful to look at.

You say there's a formal streak in your personality. Personally, we think the Malibu Classic Landau Coupe should be right up your driveway. It proudly wears a vinyl cover over the rear half-section of the roof. And the Landau roof is accented with glistening bright moldings plus bright edging framing the shiny black center pillar. Sport wheel covers and body side pinstriping add just the right touch.



And to help keep your Malibu looking good, it's protected with extensive corrosion-resisting treatments.



Standard Features.

- 1. High Energy Ignition. A solid-state system that eliminates points and ignition condenser, yet delivers a highvoltage spark that helps extend time between recommended tune-ups.
- 2. Early Fuel Evaporation. Hastens engine induction system warm-up to help provide smooth performance after starting.
- 3. Carburetor outside air intake. Ducts cooler outside air through the air cleaner into the carburetor to help assure a denser fuel-air mixture for added engine performance after
- Delco Freedom battery. Never needs refilling. Sealed side terminals help resist corrosion.
- Coolant recovery system. Helps prevent loss of coolant.
- Catalytic converter. Handles most emission control functions so engine can be initially tuned at the factory for smooth, responsive performance.
- 7. Full Coil suspension system. Puts a coil spring at each wheel that's been computer-selected for specific model and equipment weight.
- 8. Fiberglass-belted radial ply tires. Have less rolling resistance than conventional bias ply tires and offer impressive traction.
- 9. Front stabilizer bar. Helps reduce body lean during sharp turns.
- Front disc/rear drum brakes. A selfadjusting system. Fade-resistant front disc brakes have audible wear sensors to let you know when to replace pads.
- picture windows. On Malibu Sedans and Wagons this system allows the use of a rear door design with large, fixed

picture windows. This door/window design also allows for easy entry and exit and gives you recessed rear door armrests. Behind the rear windows are swing-out vents to give rear-seat passengers draft-free ventilation.

- 12. Cushioned body mounting system. Helps isolate passenger area from road noise and vibration.
- 13. Inner fenders, front & rear, Help protect outer surfaces from salt and road debris for added corrosion protection.
- 14. Foam-backed, one-piece cloth headliner. For custom appearance and sound insulation.
- 15. Full carpeting. One-piece, wall-towall carpeting covers even under the front seats.
- 16. Compact spare tire. Provides more usable room in the trunk compartment. Lighter weight makes for easier handling.
- 17. Large trunk space. Gives you 16.6 well-planned cubic feet of usable luggage capacity.
- 18. Body by Fisher, Beautiful on the outside. Rugged underneath. Doublepanel doors, hood and deck lid, boxsection roof headers and pillars, heavily ribbed and formed underbody.

3.3 LITRE OR 3.8 LITRE **V6 ENGINES**

These engines represent a blend of six-cylinder and V8 design characteristics. The engine blocks and heads are cast iron. The 3.3 Litre V6 has a crankshaft with slightly offset rod journals to help assure a firing interval with a high degree of smoothness and good dynamic balance. Practical engines for most owner applications. The 3.3 Litre engine is standard in 49 states; not available in California.


