Safety Features

Every GM car is designed with your safety in mind. Safety is a goal from the first sketches of a new car, through design models and prototypes, up to final production. All such components have been approved for use in Chevrolet products and will provide the quality performance associated with the Chevrolet name. Some options may be unavailable when your car is built Your dealer receives advice regarding current availability of options. You may ask the dealer for this information. GM also requests the dealer to advise you if an option you ordered is unavailable. We suggest that you verify that your car includes optional equipment you ordered or, if there are changes, that they are acceptable to you.
