

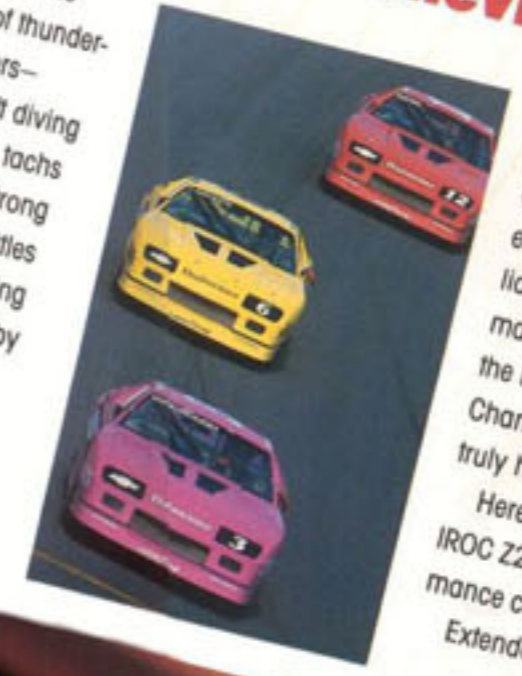

# Camaro IROC Z28. Chevrolet Rolls Out the Thunder.

Few things in life match the thrill of a squal line of thundering Camaro IROC racers—locked in a 12-car draft diving down the high banks... tachs pulsating near redline, strong leg muscles pushing throttles to floorboards, all attempting to defy the laws of physics by trying to occupy the same place at the same time.



It's enough to overwhelm anyone who likes cars. And among the team of Camaro engineers, it spawned a brilliant idea. A street-legal machine built in the spirit of the International Race of Champions. An automobile of truly heroic capabilities. Herewith the Camaro IROC Z28. One serious performance car. Extended "ground-effects"

rocker panels. A special suspension with Delco/Bilstein gas-charged rear shocks. Sixteen-inch aluminum alloy wheels mated to the renowned Goodyear Eagle VR50 Gatorbacks. But while its looks echo the glory of the Camaros that race in the International Race of Champions at Daytona, Talladega and Michigan International, IROC Z28 offers

performance thunder that's all its own. Do Camaro engineers extract any unfair advantage in associating with some of the world's top race-car builders and drivers? When posed this question, the engineers can only smile. "That's for IROC owners to decide."



# Camaro Performance. Available 5.0 Liter V8 With Tuned-Port Injection. As Quick as It Is Beautiful.

Appearances are not deceiving.

The gleaming aluminum plenum. The symmetrical matrix of plumbing. Like a masterpiece bred in a Stuttgart race shop.

It's called Tuned-Port Fuel Injection (TPI). A sharing of GM and Bosch technology. One of the most sophisticated automotive fuel-injection systems there is. Paired with the rock-solid small-block V8 that has more racing wins than any other production engine.

Available on Z28 and IROC Z28, the 5.0 Liter V8 with TPI was designed for impressive surges of horsepower and torque, across the power band, in any gear.

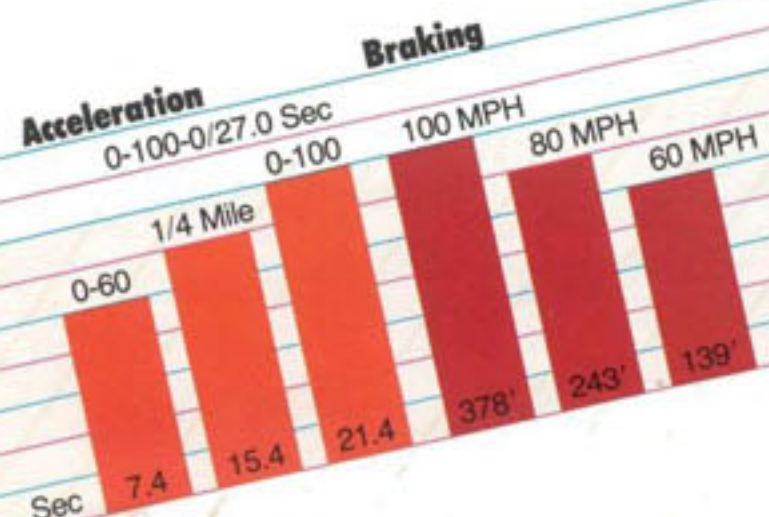
Tuned runners girdle the plenum to ram precisely controlled volumes of pressurized air into eight cylinder inlet ports. Meanwhile, exact amounts of fuel are delivered via a fuel rail system and sprayed into the ports through eight Bosch injectors.

Precision is the key to this technology. Such that an electronic control module continually measures air mass, altitude, ambient temperature and humidity. Then adjusts the injector's pulse duration with computer speed and accuracy.

Besides excellent power and torque, Tuned-Port Fuel Injection is designed for:

- Instant throttle response.
- Standard electronic spark control ignition allows use of different octane gasolines without knocking.
- Dependable operation. The only moving parts are the throttle plate, idle controls and the electronic fuel injectors. All else is solid-state circuitry sealed from dirt, dust and moisture.
- Dependable cold starts without flooding delays from pumping the accelerator reduce the chance of battery failure or starter motor burnout.
- Dependable hot starts without vapor lock delays.
- Self-adjusting idle to help prevent stalling when cold and fuel waste when warm.
- Automatic idle increase when accessories are engaged to help maintain battery charge.
- Reduced maintenance (no choke, carburetor, accelerator pump or needle valve adjustment required).
- Self-pressurizing systems provide easy starts after refueling without priming the system if you run out of gas.
- Positive fuel shutoff helps prevent "run-on" after engine is switched off.

Note: Performance data was compiled by a professional driver on a GM test track. Test vehicle was a Camaro IROC Z28 with optional Tuned-Port Fuel-Injected 5.0 Liter V8 and 4-speed automatic transmission.

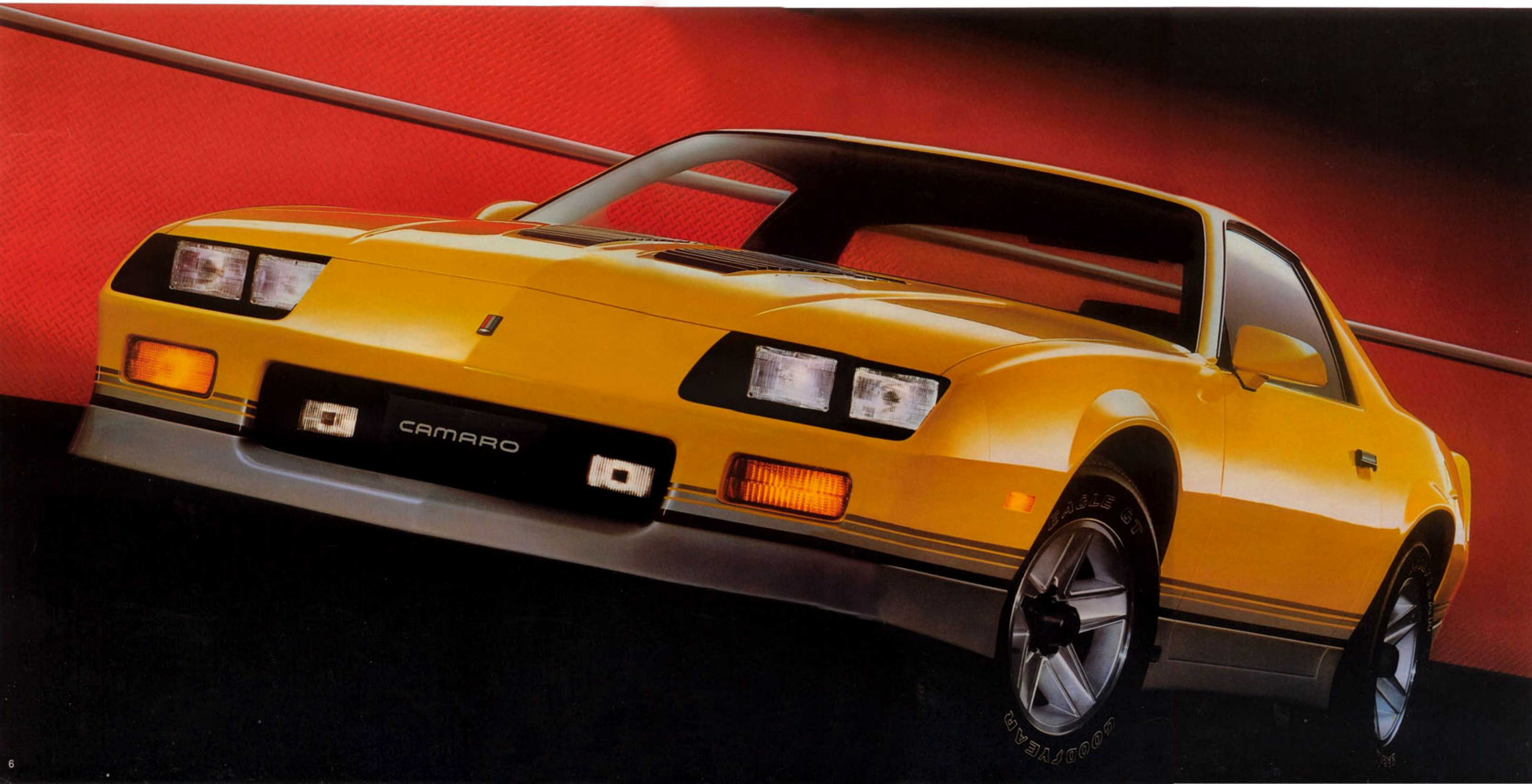

- The lively 2.5 Liter fuel-injected four-cylinder, standard on Sport Coupe. (Not shown.)

## Camaro Sport Coupe. The Lowest-Priced Camaro Develops a Snarl.

The premise was simple. Build a performance Camaro at a Sport Coupe price.

And after some spirited discussions and intense engineering, impressive things began to happen. Camaro Sport Coupe was suddenly becoming something to be reckoned with.

The first clue was the exterior. The engineers replaced the standard wheels and tires with P205/70R-14 radials mounted on Rally Wheels with trim rings. Next, they blacked out the headlamp pockets, rockers and lower facias and added a sport stripe around the rocker panels. Then they gave the car new base coat/clear coat paint (now standard on all Camaros) and added dual Sport mirrors.

Next was the suspension. The engineers eagerly added

the renowned sport suspension system with specific shocks, springs and other components and painstakingly tuned it to the new tires.

For even more fun, the engineers lowered in an available 2.8 Liter V6 with Multi-Port Fuel Injection linked to a 5-speed manual gearbox with performance axle ratio.

Finally, it had to sound right, so they added a throaty sport-tone exhaust system.

Goodyear Eagle GT P215/65R-15 on 15" by 7"

Rally Wheels are standard with the 2.8 Liter V6 and the available 5.0 Liter V8 also.

There it was—a Sport Coupe package that had anyone who drove it walking around with a chronic silly grin.

Said one engineer, "Projects like this appeal to the car nut in all of us. It's a real kick building a car so good that so many people can afford."

## Camaro Berlinetta. Elegance With a Technical Touch.

Performance in an automobile can have many different definitions depending on the kind of driver you are and the kinds of distances you travel. It was with this in mind that Chevrolet engineers created Berlinetta, the grand touring Camaro with a unique electronic instrumentation system to help keep your senses in touch with the road, mile after mile.

Dual pods flank the instrument cluster area, placing lights, available climate control system, turn signals and wiper controls all within a finger's reach of the steering wheel.

Large blue-green vacuum-fluorescent numerals indicate your cruising speed. A push of a button converts these numbers from miles per hour to kilometers. Another button converts the odometer to a digital RPM readout in addition to the standard bar-graph tach.

Equally unique is the swivel

pod-style Delco electronically tuned, 4-speaker, full-feature AM/FM stereo radio.\* Seek and scan, digital display, front coaxial and extended range rear speakers are standard. Graphic equalizer with liquid-fluorescent readouts and a cassette player are optional.

Berlinetta's road-going elegance is further enhanced by its responsive 2.8 Liter V6 with Multi-Port Fuel Injection and 5-speed manual transmission. A powerful 5.0 Liter V8, teamed with a 4-speed auto-

matic, is also available.

"I like to think of Berlinetta as I do the best stereos," said one Camaro engineer. "You don't have to turn it all the way up to know how good it is."

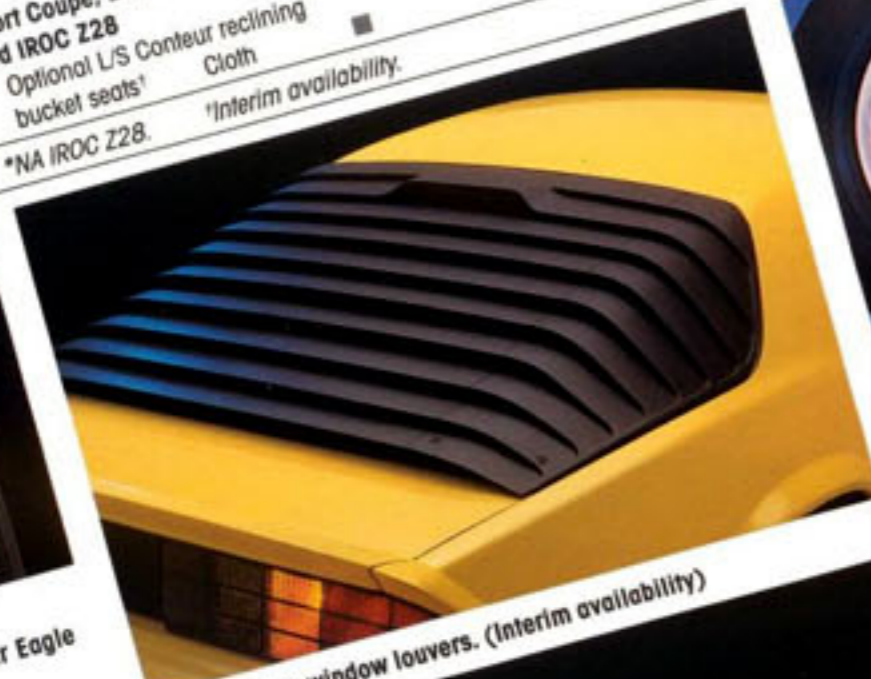
