

A specially-tuned De Carbon shock absorber and coil spring at each wheel deliver impressive ride characteristics while maintaining road feel. The special Ride and Handling Suspension also includes tuned front and rear stabilizer bars.



Standard on Impala SS: a large-diameter disc brake at each wheel and a four-wheel anti-lock brake system (ABS).

Injection provides outstanding performance through a wide RPM range. The electronically controlled 4-speed automatic transmission delivers precise, virtually undetectable upshifts and downshifts during normal driving, with shift timing that is perfectly matched to the performance characteristics of the LT1 V8.

The LT1 delivers the power, but equally impressive is the way Impala SS responds when the road turns twisty. A Special Ride and Handling Suspension, quick-ratio power steering and P255/50ZR-17 tires work together to deliver a compliant ride and responsive handling. Standard four-wheel disc brakes and a four-wheel anti-lock brake system (ABS) add to the feeling of confidence.

There are other sport sedans offering similar V8 power and performance technology. They also happen to cost about twice as much as the 1994 Impala SS.

Additional luxury features: Tilt-Wheel™ Adjustable Steering Column, power windows and power door locks, power driver seat, and electronic speed control. A Delco AM/FM stereo with a seek-scan feature, cassette tape player and digital clock is standard. Or, you may order the optional Delco AM/FM stereo with integral CD. Both systems provide sound that is precisely tailored to the interior acoustics of Impala SS.

Impala SS safety features include dual air bags, 4-wheel ABS and a rugged steel "safety cage" surrounding the entire passenger compartment. This cage is so strong it helps Impala SS meet 1997 Federal side-impact standards today.

Also standard: PASS-Key II, a totally passive theft-deterrent system. Only your special coded ignition key starts your Impala SS. If an attempt is made to start the car without the proper key, the ignition system is disabled.

The GM 3-year/36,000-mile (whichever comes first) limited warranty covers repairs for all 1994 Impalas, including labor and parts, to correct any defects in material or workmanship occurring during the warranty period. Warranty features include air conditioning repair, towing, no-cost warranty transfer, 6-year/100,000-mile (whichever comes first) body sheet-metal rust-through protection and 5-year/50,000-mile (whichever comes first) emissions control system coverage. Items not covered by the warranty include tires (which are covered by their manufacturer) and normal maintenance. See your Chevrolet dealer for terms of this limited warranty.

Courtesy Transportation. Customers who purchase or lease a 1994 Impala SS will be able to take advantage of Courtesy Transportation at no additional charge when their vehicles are left at a participating dealership for repairs covered under the 3-year/36,000-mile New Vehicle Limited Warranty. See your participating dealer for details.

24-Hour Roadside Assistance. For as long as you own your 1994 Impala SS, the security and convenience of round-the-clock Roadside Assistance is available via a toll-free hot line (1-800-CHEV-USA). Your call will be answered by a Roadside Assistance phone advisor trained by Chevrolet.
