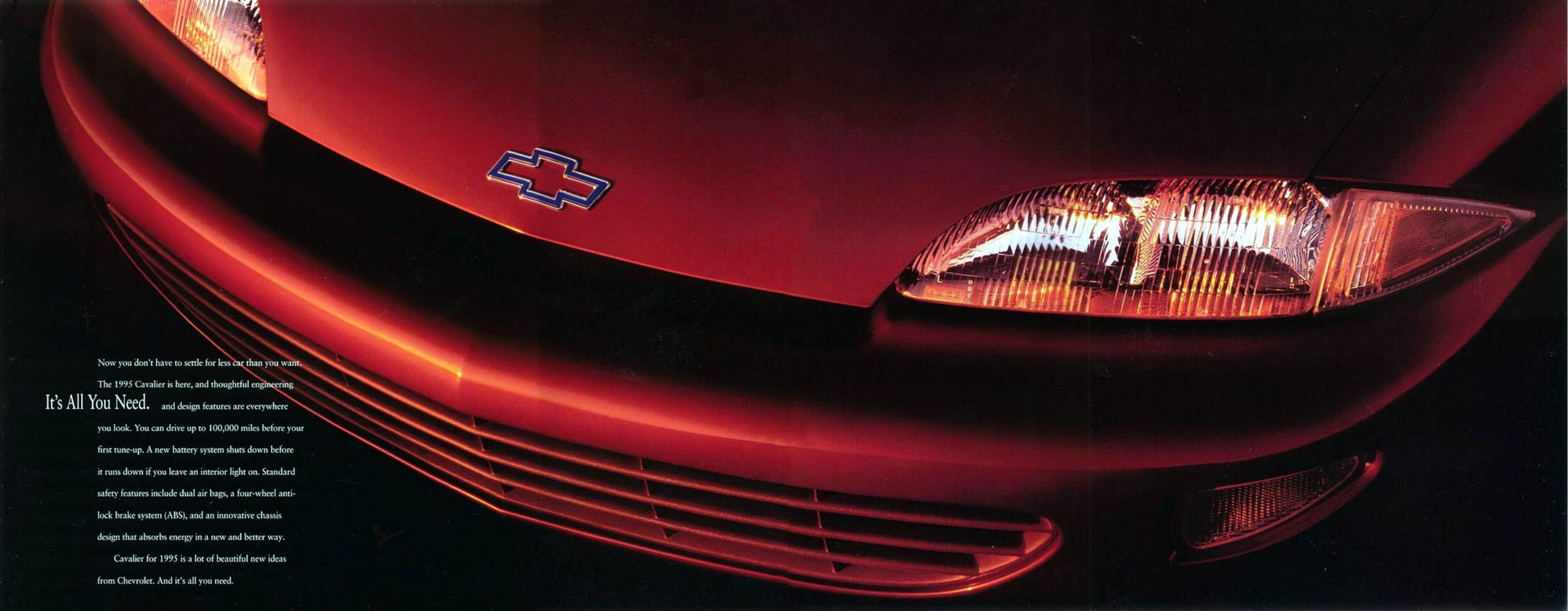

Platinum-tipped spark plugs, transmission fluid and rear shock absorbers are designed to last up to 100,000 miles. A direct fire ignition system is designed to eliminate the need for periodic engine timing adjustments.

Four-Wheel ABS.

A four-wheel anti-lock brake system (ABS) is standard in every 1995 Cavalier. ABS reduces wheel lockup during severe braking and is designed to help you maintain steering control, even in a panic stop in rain or snow.

Dual Air Bags.

Driver and front-passenger air bags are standard. They can help protect front-seat occupants in certain moderate to severe frontal collisions. Remember to always wear safety belts, even in cars equipped with air bags.

Safety-Cage Construction.

A rigid safety cage surrounds the entire passenger compartment of Cavalier Coupe and Cavalier Sedan. Side-door beams and energy-absorbing front and rear body structures complete this safety envelope.

Scotchgard™ Protector.

Scotchgard™ Protector, on cloth seats and door trim, is standard in every 1995 Cavalier, for soil resistance and easy cleanup.

Base-Coat/Clear-Coat Paint.

The 1995 Cavalier features base-coat/clear-coat paint that not only provides a more durable, lustrous finish, but also reduces the severity of water-spotting and etching from acid rain.

Battery-Saver System.

This system automatically shuts off interior lights (should you forget to do so) after the car has been sitting with the ignition off for 20 minutes. It also cuts power to accessories after 24 days to help alleviate battery rundown.

Front-Wheel Drive.

The combination of front-wheel drive and all-season tires helps provide excellent traction and driving stability in the snow. Power steering, standard on all models, makes in-city parking and maneuvering easier.

Child-Security Locks.

In consumer focus groups, parents voted overwhelmingly in favor of child security rear-door locks, so they are standard in every '95 Cavalier Sedan. These door locks, when engaged, prevent the rear doors from being opened from the inside.

In a Cavalier, you can travel up to 100,000 miles before your first scheduled engine tune-up. Advanced platinum-tipped spark plugs and rear shock absorbers aren't scheduled for replacement until the 100,000-mile mark, and a long-life serpentine accessory drive belt is designed to never need tensioning. Under normal driving conditions, the automatic transmission fluid should never need replacing.

The Cavalier 2.2 Liter engine features a direct fire ignition system that eliminates the need for periodic timing adjustment. Multi-Port Fuel Injection delivers an ultra-smooth idle and exceptional throttle response.

All Cavalier body panels except the roof are constructed of rust-resistant two-side-galvanized steel. The rust-fighting technology is so advanced that the body of every Cavalier is warranted for rust-through protection for 6 years/100,000 miles, whichever comes first. This is protection against corrosion that is unsurpassed in the auto industry.

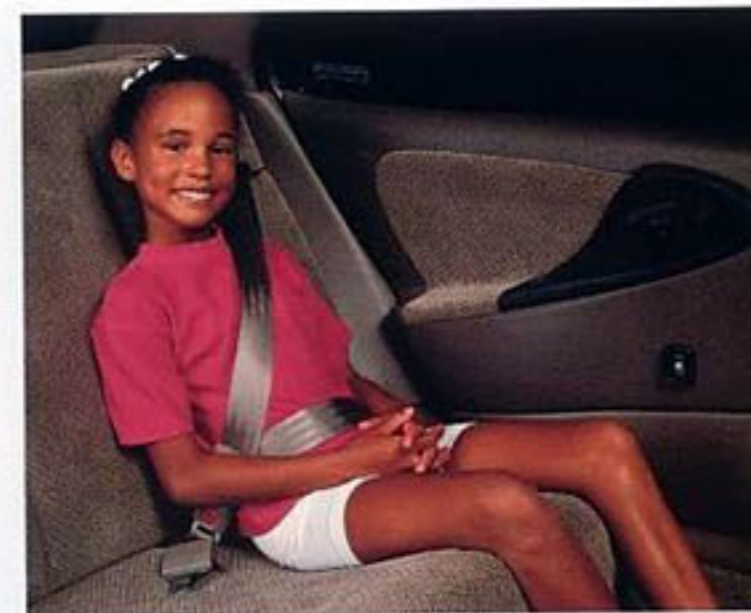

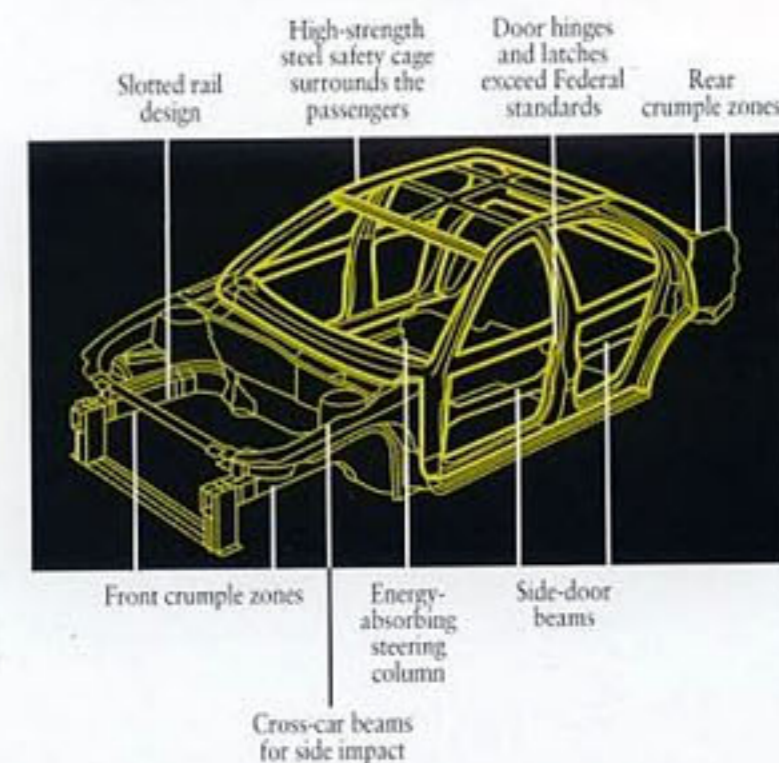

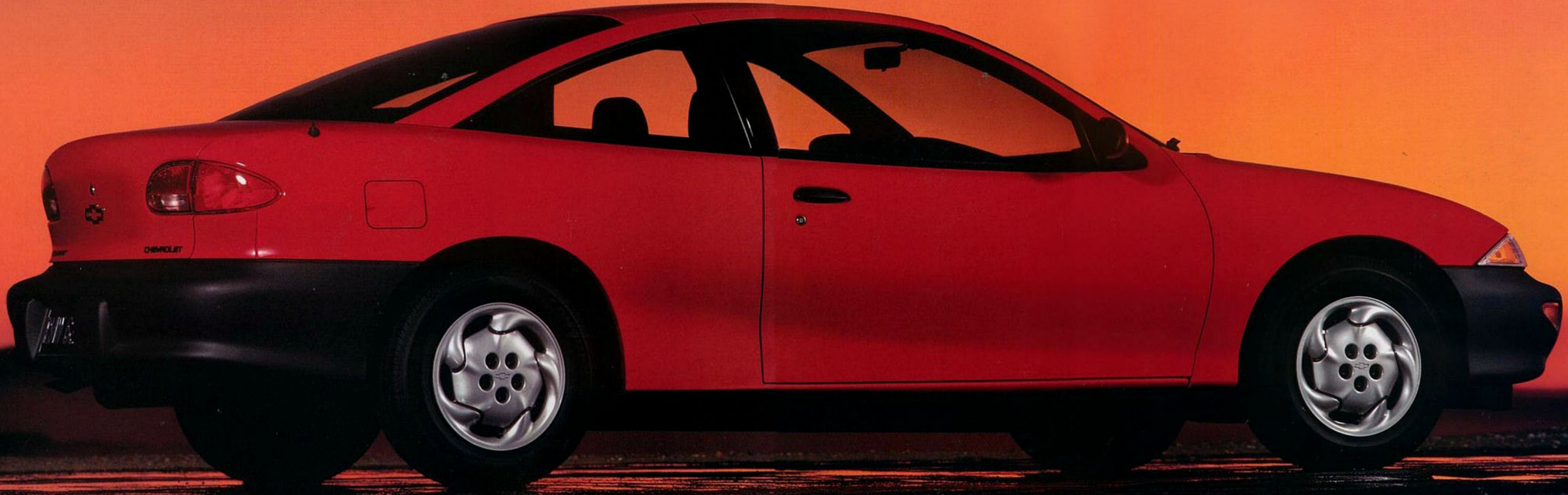
