'83 FULL-SIZE 4X4 CHEVY BLAZER. CHEVY'S ULTIMATE OFF-ROAD ANIMAL.

Only sport utility vehicle to offer a diesel V8: Full-size, 4-wheel drive and room for five — with an optional folding rear seat. The new full-size Chevy Blazer is the all-out way to go 4-wheeling. Offered only as a tough 4-wheel-drive model, it offers a choice of gas or available diesel power. In town, it's a comfortable 2WD cruiser. In 4WD country, it's an off-road animal. **Diesel V8 available.** An available 6.2 Liter (379 Cu. In.) V8 Diesel engine was created specifically for truck use. No other sport utility

vehicle offers a V8 diesel engine. Its fuel economy is impressive. Rated at 130 SAE net HP, it has the low-speed torque needed to get you through off-road situations. Properly equipped, a diesel-powered 4WD Chevy Blazer can move up to 11,000 lbs., including itself, passengers, cargo, equipment and trailer. The required transmission is the optional 4-speed automatic with overdrive.

V8 gas engine is standard (not available in California). A 4-speed manual transmission is standard. In California, the optional 5.7 Liter (350 Cu. In.) V8 engine without Electronic Spark Control is available.

The required transmission is the optional 4-speed automatic with overdrive. **2WD to 4WD without stopping.** Chevy Blazer's 4-wheel-drive system features automatic locking front hubs and a lightweight transfer case with synchronized gears in high. The transfer case and front axle prop don't turn in 2-wheel drive, which reduces wear and contributes to fuel economy. When you shift from freewheeling 2WD to 4WD

at speeds under 25 MPH, the hubs automatically lock up. You never have to leave the cab to lock or unlock the hubs. **Available seating for five.** With the optional rear seat, full-size Chevy Blazer can carry five adults (at 150 lbs. each), plus 1124 lbs. of payload — 1874 lbs. total gross payload. (Gross payload includes driver, passengers, equipment and cargo.) With the rear seat

folded down, there is almost 5 ft. of load length. **An impressive ride.** The front suspension includes leaf springs, a stabilizer bar and double-acting shock absorbers. **Built off-road tough.** Double-wall construction is featured in the steel windshield pillars, cowl, hood, front fenders, tailgate and rear side panels.
