POWER TO PULL OR PUSH.

Properly equipped, a diesel- or gas-powered Blazer can tow up to 11,000 lbs., including itself, passengers, cargo, equipment and trailer. Your dealer has details on specially equipped Blazers for snowplow applications.

THE BIG SHIFT.

2WD to 4WD *High* without stopping. How does it work? At the heart of this remarkable 4-wheel-drive system is a husky transfer case with synchronized gearing that lets you shift in and out of 4WD without leaving the cab. When you shift from 2WD to 4WD *High* at

4-WHEEL-DRIVE GEAR SELECTION.

A lighted, floor-mounted shift console tells you the gear you're in. 2HI for driving on paved surfaces with the front hubs disengaged; 4HI for normal operation on unpaved surfaces with the front and rear axles engaged and the front hubs locked. 4LO is for traveling on low-traction surfaces.



speeds under 25 MPH, Blazer's automatic-locking hubs engage, so you don't have to stop and get out of the cab to set them.

To switch back to 2WD, simply stop the vehicle, shift into 2WD, slowly back up about ten feet, then go on your way.

With the optional rear seat, Chevy Blazer can comfortably carry five adults, plus 850 lbs. of payload—1,680 lbs. total gross payload, including driver, passengers, equipment and cargo. With the rear seat folded down, there is almost five feet of usable load length.
